What is Parent Topic- Sue Kenser indicated what this meetings will be all about. A flyer will be sent home.




Jill McGlone, Educational Specialist, spoke about Dialogic Reading. Information was given. She indicated to find a book with pictures and a simple story for this age. She said to ask open ended question. She spoke about parent as teacher and advocate for your child. We have a program called Ready Rosie. Jill McGlone stated what this all involves. Carla Malone stated what Response to Intervention (RTI) is. It is just a different way of learning for the child and to present it different since we do not all learn the same way.

Johanna Culver, Bus Monitor Coordinator, discussed bus and pedestrian safety. She explained how the child has to be given hand to hand to an adult. Once we receive your child, they are our responsibility. They practice evacuation drills 2-4 times a year. If crossing the street, the monitor has to be with this because of the state law. Safety is very important for our program. She indicated if someone is not home to get the child off the bus, they will go to Cannonsburg Daycare. There is a cost to this. The child is never left alone. Remember the persons on the emergency card will be the ones to get the child off the bus. If you need to add or take off someone, then you will have to come in person.

Penny Fuller, Counselor, is on our staff and onsite for our program. She stated she does group lessons on safety, character building, handwashing. She will also meet with children one on one.
