Healthy at School Guidelines

Transportation

- Seats will be assigned for each route
- Siblings will sit together
- Buses will be disinfected after each run

Contact Tracing

- Per KDPH Guidelines-contact tracing will no longer take place at the school level or the local health department

BCPS/ETHOS Testing Centers

- Bob McCullough Drive Center 7:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.
- Oakland Ave. Baptist Church 7:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m.
- Testing centers are open to students, staff, and family members of BCPS students
- Please preregister at www.ethosbacktoschool.com

Health

- Each school will have a designated Health Services Assistant
- Temperature checks will be provided for students and staff members as needed
- Hand sanitizer will be provided in each classroom and throughout the building
- Each school will have a designated quarantine room
- Non-essential visitors may be limited
- 3 foot physical distancing whenever possible
- Students who return from a positive COVID-19 case between days six through ten, will be required to wear a mask through day ten
- Students must be asymptomatic to return on days six through ten
- If a student is not asymptomatic after day 5 of isolation, they should return to school following day ten
 - Students placed on quarantine or isolation will receive educational services through their classroom teachers with assistance from our BCPS QRS teachers
- Use of outdoor facilities whenever possible, outdoor tents will be available for school use
- Additional staff members are in place to serve our quarantine receiving services students and regular classroom operations
- Use of NTI days, temporary remote instruction, or school closures if needed

Healthy at School Guidelines

Meals

- Lunch/breakfast procedures will vary by school, but will follow current safety guidelines as much as possible
- As much as possible, provide more space between students when meals are served
- Meal options will expand to pre-COVID guidelines

Visitors

- Nonessential visitors and volunteers may be limited

Cleaning

- High touch surfaces will be cleaned regularly throughout the day
- High level cleaning and additional sanitizing will take place each evening and as needed

Athletics

- BCPS will follow the current KHSAA guidelines

COVID-19 Symptoms Information

February 8, 2022

- Fever greater than 100.4
- New Cough
- Vomiting, Diarrhea or stomachache
- Loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Runny nose/congestion
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever
- Muscle/body aches

Out of an abundance of caution, we may send your child home if they exhibit any of the above symptoms. Your child may return to school once they have been fever and/or symptom free for 24 hours (without the use of fever reducing medication) **OR** they have received an alternate diagnosis and a release to return to school from the healthcare provider.
