Healthy at School Guidelines

Transportation

- Seats will be assigned for each route
- Buses will be disinfected each day

Contact Tracing

- Per KDPH Guidelines-contact tracing will no longer take place at the school level or at the local health department

COVID Testing

- Free COVID tests will be available at each school for parents to pick up if needed

Health

- Each school will have a designated Health Services Assistant
- Temperature checks will be provided for students and staff members as needed
- Hand sanitizer will be provided throughout the building
- Each school will have a designated quarantine room
- 3 foot physical distancing whenever possible
- Please notify your child's school if your child tests positive for COVID-19
 - Your child's school will give you information concerning instruction, assignments, and make-up work
- If your child tests positive, your child must be symptom free to return on days six through ten
- Students who return from a positive COVID-19 case between days six through ten, will be required to wear a mask through day ten
- If a student is not symptom free after day 5 of isolation, they should return to school when symptom free or following day ten
- Use of outdoor facilities whenever possible
- Use of 10 NTI days or school closures if needed
- Masks are encouraged but NOT required

Healthy at School Guidelines

Meals

- Lunch/breakfast procedures will vary by school, but will follow current safety guidelines as much as possible

Cleaning

- High touch surfaces will be cleaned regularly throughout the day
- High level cleaning and additional sanitizing will take place each evening and as needed

Athletics

- BCPS will follow the current KHSAA guidelines

COVID-19 Symptoms Information

July 1, 2022

- ___ Fever greater than 100.4
- ___ New Cough
- ___ Vomiting, Diarrhea or stomachache
- ___ Loss of taste or smell
- ___ Sore throat
- ___ Runny nose/congestion
- ___ Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- ___ New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever
- ___ Muscle/body aches

Out of an abundance of caution, we may send your child home if they exhibit any of the above symptoms. Your child may return to school once they have been fever and/or symptom free for 24 hours (without the use of fever reducing medication) **OR** they have received an alternate diagnosis and a release to return to school from the healthcare provider.
